In accordance with the recommendation of the San Joaquin County Office of Education, Stockton Collegiate will remain closed through the end of the 2019-20 school year. Superintendent Mousalimas' recommendation is based on direction from Governor Newsom and Tony Thurmond, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, and was made in consultation with San Joaquin County Public Health Officer Dr. Maggie Park.

Distance learning will be provided through the remainder of the school year.

For PYP students, the transition to distance learning is in process. Administrators, coordinators, and teachers have been working this week to prepare the shift from enrichment activities to distance learning.
